Focus:

The Reframing Mathematics Futures II (RMFII)¹ project is working with 32 schools nationally to explore algebraic, spatial and statistical reasoning in Years 7-10. We are in the process of collecting student data with a view to building evidence-based learning progressions, assessment tools and teaching advice to support the teaching and learning of mathematical reasoning in the middle years of schooling and beyond.

Members of the RMFII research team will be visiting RMFII project schools around the country to share what we have learnt to date about what students find difficult and what is needed to help them develop their capacity to reason mathematically.

In the interests of sharing this work more widely and receiving some feedback on the learning progressions and targeted teaching activities, we would like to extend this opportunity to teachers in other schools.
